**RESOLUTION NO. 870**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROY,  
PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON, ADOPTING A SIX YEAR  
COMPREHENSIVE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT  
PROGRAM.**

**WHEREAS**, RCW 35.77 requires the governing body of each Washington city to adopt a Six Year Comprehensive Transportation Improvement Program; and

**WHEREAS**, RCW 35.77 requires the plan be reviewed annually and public meetings held regarding the plan and the need for any revisions of the plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council held a public hearing on June 11, 2018, where testimony regarding the plan was requested and considered from members of the public, the City's staff and the Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has determined that the plan should be adopted for the upcoming six-year period;


**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Roy, Washington:

**Section 1.** That the attached Six Year Comprehensive Transportation Improvement Program is hereby adopted and shall be made available in the City Clerk-Treasurer's Office.

**Section 2.** Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution should be held to be unconstitutional or unlawful by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution.

**Section 3.** All acts consistent with this Resolution are hereby authorized.
