

## HISTORY

"Initially there was only one station agent and one telegraph office between Tacoma and Kalama, both located at Tenino. However the physical needs to the train itself facilitated the need to have various refuiling points along the lines. Early trains were stream powered and they could only go a certain distance without having to refill their boilers back up with water. The future community of Roy, initially called MEdia, happened to be exactly halfway between Tenino and Tacoma, and was the perfect location for a refueling stop. Initially there was just a platform beside the tracks, and a large water tank.

Enticed by looking for a good place to fish, in I883 James McNaught (General Council for NPRR) and Dr. Samuel Warren (NPRR physician in charge of the incidents on the between Tenino to Tacoma), embarked in Media to fish in the atrea that McNaught had recently purchased. McNaught's purchase was slightly over 600 acres. Impressed by the possiblities of the region, Drr. Warren suggested that, "...a town should be located in that beautiful seciton and an organized sttelment established if only to funish conveniences and accommodations to the fishermen (Baccuss I995:I9) -WHR Form - Roy Water Tank Application
