Hydrant Flushing Oct. 6-9th.

Although the iron flushed from the water system is not harmful, it can stain plumbing fixtures and discolor clothing. Avoid running your tap water and avoid using your washing machine or dishwasher if you see a crew flushing a hydrant on your street. Tap water used during the flushing process may have sediment that causes discoloration. When laundering clothes, wait until the water runs clear at the tap, then wash a load of dark clothes first. If you notice discolored water, simply shut the water off and wait several minutes. After waiting, check the clarity by running cold water for a few minutes, allowing it to work its way through your pipes. In some cases, slight discoloration may linger

for a few hours. This discoloration only affects the appearance of the water and does not affect water quality. There is no health hazard associated with discolored water from hydrant flushing. If water pressure or water volume seems low, check the faucet screens for trapped particles.
